DECLARATION OF BENJAMIN J. ALKE

- I, Benjamin J. Alke, declare as follows:
- 1. I am one of the attorneys principally responsible for handling this matter.
- I am personally familiar with the facts set forth in this
 Declaration. If called as a witness, I could competently testify to the matters stated herein.
- 3. I, along with Devlan Geddes, Jeffrey Tierney, John Crist, and Henry Tesar are the attorneys for the Plaintiffs and class representatives in this case and for the Class.
- 4. I am a lawyer admitted to practice by the Supreme Court of Montana in 2006. I am also licensed to practice in Oregon. Subsequently, I have been admitted in the United States District Court for the District of Montana, the United States Court of Appeals, and the United States Supreme Court. To the best of my knowledge, I am presently in good standing with all the above-named courts.
- 5. I am a partner of the law firm Crist, Krogh, Alke & Nord PLLC. I am writing this declaration in support of Plaintiffs' Motion for Class Certification and, specifically, to establish that my firm is appropriate and qualified Class Counsel pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 23(a)(4) and (g), and that I will adequately and fairly represent the interests of the putative class.

- 6. Crist, Krogh, Alke & Nord PLLC, or predecessor law firms involving some or all these lawyers, has been in existence for over 25 years.
